What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	<a href="#">In-Network</a> : \$6,500 Individual / \$13,000 Family <a href="#">Out-of-Network</a> : Not Applicable	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes. <a href="#">Preventive care</a> , office visits, certain diagnostic tests, certain imaging, certain <a href="#">prescription drugs</a> , <a href="#">urgent care</a> , outpatient <a href="#">rehabilitation</a> are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> .	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	Yes.	This <a href="#">plan</a> will pay some or all of the costs to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> for covered services but only if you have a <a href="#">referral</a> before you see the <a href="#">specialist</a> .
